His role is to represent the interests of boys in our district and model and attitude, character, and lifestyle of a Royal Ranger and FCF member for other boys in our district.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Be a born-again Christian, consistently modeling Christlike character and lifestyle.
2. Be no more than 16 ½ years of age as of the time of scout testing.
3. Be an active member of a Royal Rangers outpost.
4. Be an active member of the Daniel Boone FCF Chapter for at least (1) year.
5. Be approved for consideration by the Chapter FCF committee and District Commander.
6. Satisfactorily complete the chapter scout testing process.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Attend all chapter FCF team meetings.
2. Assist in planning, organizing, and conducting chapter FCF events as directed by the FCF Chapter President.
3. Assist in building and lighting the council fires at all chapter FCF events.
4. Assemble a complete FCF outfit and wear it regularly at all FCF events.
5. Work to attend all territorial and national FCF rendezvous taking place during your term of office.
6. Wear the FCF Assistant Chapter Scout name tag on your Royal Rangers uniform or awards vest for the duration of your term of office.
7. Participate in the Chapter FCF Young Bucks Council and assist in conducting periodic council events under the direction of the Chapter FCF President. These councils should be conducted at least once annually to gather feedback and input from the young buck members of our chapter on all FCF events.
8. Promote FCF membership among the boys of our district and encourage boys to pursue advancement within FCF once membership is attained.
9. Be available to assume the role of District Scout in his absence.
